Maintenance of Status and I-94 Consent Form

International Scholars Operations (ISO)

Maintenance of status is essential to your ability to remain legally in the United States. Violating your status can have serious consequences ranging from the denial of a petition to change or extend status, to initiation of removal (deportation) proceedings against you by the U.S. government, to a three- or ten-year bar on entry into the U.S. Violations of status include, **but are not limited to**:

- (1) Unauthorized work (with or without pay);
- (2) Failure to timely extend nonimmigrant status;
- (3) Dropping below full-time status (as a student OR an employee);
- (4) Lying to the U.S. government;
- (5) Commission of crimes; and
- (6) Purchase, sale, use, or possession of illegal drugs (including marijuana).

In order to remain in the U.S., it is very important that you avoid violating your status and that you check your I-94 Arrival/Departure record at https://i94.cbp.dhs.gov/I94/ every time you enter the United States to make sure that it is accurate. In particular, please make sure that your I-94 record lists the correct visa category and "admit until" date. If there are any errors on your I-94 record, please contact ISO right away so that we can provide information on how to have them corrected by U.S. Customs & Border Protection.
